Build a 3D model of a Greek vase. You could use any materials to sculpt your masterpiece!



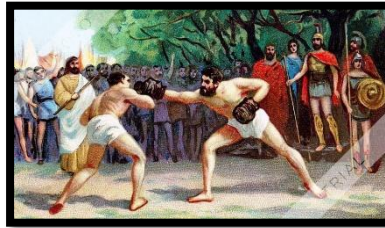
Create a PowerPoint about a chosen mythical creature. You could focus on: the minotaur, hydra or even a centaur.



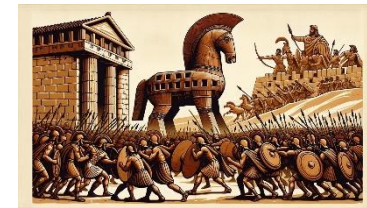
Find out about Greek temples and draw your own temple!



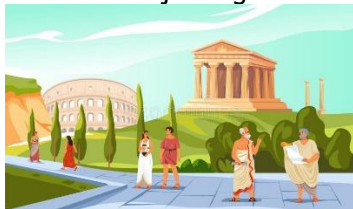
Record a sports commentary for an Olympic sport of your choice. Don't forget to use your voice to make it interesting!



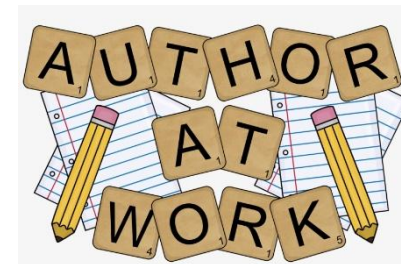
Retell the story of the Trojan War as if you were one of the soldiers hiding in the wooden horse!
